



RULES & POLICIES

The following is an outline of the Rules & Policies adopted by a resolution of the Board of Directors, effective April 1, 2010. The Board of Directors has granted the Pro Shop and Clubhouse Management the authority to enforce these directives.

RULES OF PLAY

1. All play must start at the Number 1 tee, unless otherwise authorized by the Pro Shop personnel. Order of play will be determined by the Starter.
2. Starting times for restricted members shall begin at 11:30 am on Saturdays, and at 10:30 a.m. on Sundays and Holidays, unless otherwise determined at the discretion of the pro. (Please note: As of November 19, 2007, children under the age of 16 are defined as "restricted members").
3. No Single or Twosome is allowed on the course on Weekends or Holidays until 1:00 pm. Any exception will be made by the Golf Professionals.
4. Children under sixteen (16) years of age are not permitted to drive golf carts nor are they permitted in the locker rooms.
5. Children under twelve (12) years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
6. Men are requested to refrain from starting on Thursdays between the hours of 8:30 am and 11:00 am.
7. Members and Guests must sign in at the Pro Shop before starting play.
8. No Guest may play the course more than two (2) times per month, regardless who is the host. Social Members, Members on Leave, Non-Member children or grandchildren are considered guests. Any deviation from the above requires Board approval.
9. Greens fees for Guests: Weekdays - \$50.00; Saturday, Sunday, and Holidays \$55.00; any day after 5:00 pm - \$25.00.
10. During the off season, non-members are prohibited from using the golf course. Any violation will result in penalty of double greens fees per person charged to any member accompanying said non-member. The exception is if Club personnel are available to collect green fees.
11. Only one (1) guest per member on Saturdays prior to 10:30 am.
12. Guests are not permitted to play the course without a member present in each foursome, unless otherwise authorized by the Board of Directors.

13. Those members with delinquent accounts lose all clubhouse and golf privileges.
14. Each player must have a golf bag and clubs.
15. **MONDAYS – NO PLAY BEFORE NOON.**

DRESS CODE

1. Proper dress is required at all times. Jeans, denim shorts or coach's shorts are not allowed on the golf course or in the dining room.
2. Men are required to wear shirts with sleeves and collars. Bermuda shorts (no more than four (4) inches above the knee) are acceptable. Slacks must have a hem.
3. Women are required to wear mid-thigh shorts, skirts or slacks.
4. Shorts are permitted in the dining room.
5. Hats and visors will not be permitted in the dining room.

Violators of the above will be turned away from the Clubhouse, Golf Course, and the Practice Area. Please advise your guests of these rules or they will also be turned away if improperly dressed.

GOLF CART USAGE

Careless use of the golf carts in regard to speeding, failure to use cart paths, failure to adhere to directional signs on fairways, and driving within thirty (30) feet of greens will result in denial of further use of carts.

GOLF SHOES

Soft spikes are required.

CONDUCT AT THE CLUB

1. No alcoholic beverages are permitted except those purchased on premise. No coolers are permitted on the golf course. Littering is prohibited.
2. Language, conduct or behavior disrespectful to others members, guests or club employees will not be tolerated.
3. In the interest of making everyone's round more enjoyable, all golfers are expected to maintain the pace of play.

PLEASE BE ADVISED OF THE FOLLOWING:

1. Any member who willfully violates these rules and policies will be subject to disciplinary action.
2. Violators will be advised in writing by the Board of Directors with a request for a written explanation.

3. If, during the same calendar year, a rule is violated for a second time; a personal appearance before the Board of Directors will be required by the member for a review of the member's privileges at the club.
4. Unless otherwise stated herein, annual dues are non-refundable for any reason, in whole or in part.

LEAVE OF ABSENCE POLICY

All leaves are subject to Board approval and can be granted for:

1. Medical reasons making a member unable to play golf. Request for a Medical Leave must be submitted to the Board of Directors in writing and be accompanied by a Doctor's note of explanation. The medical leave will be considered effective as of the date it is approved by a vote of the Board of Directors, typically at the next, regularly scheduled Board meeting after the request is received from a member.
2. Relocation out of the Buffalo golf district, i.e., job transfer. Request for an Out-of-Area leave must be submitted to the Board of Directors in writing. The member must document their new address outside the Buffalo district.

A member on a Medical Leave or Out-of-Area leave retains the use of the clubhouse and has charge privileges. No dues or monthly minimums apply. These leaves are granted for a maximum of one (1) year from the date approved.

3. Open Leave, as per Article I, Sec. 7 of the Springville Country Club By-Laws.
 - Intentions to take this leave must be submitted in writing to the Board of Directors. Approval is at the discretion of the Board of Directors.
 - Member must be in good standing for ten (10) years to be eligible for an Open Leave.
 - This leave can be used once in the lifetime of the membership.
 - The Open Leave will be for consecutive years and of unlimited duration.
 - The member on Open Leave is responsible for all club fees and assessments for each year on leave, i.e., mortgage repayment.
 - The member on an Open Leave has guest privileges only. Their membership number will be put on hold.
